Study Outline

Entry Requirements

Entry requirements are ideally GCSE Grade D or above and through initial diagnostic assessment. Learners will also have to attend an interview with a member of the construction team

Equipment

You will have to provide your own stationery equipment including writing paper, pens, HB and 2H pencils, lever arch file, equipment consumables, Personal Protective equipment to include high-Vis vest and safety boots/shoes.

Attendance

Attendance is usually one day per week at college and four days per week in the work place. This will be confirmed with your employer

Assessment

Assessment is via completion of coursework and portfolio and awarding body set examinations.

Progression

You can progress on to further training or into full-time employment as a specialist furniture fitter.
