Study Outline

Your study programme will expect you to undertake a GCSE in Mathematics if not achieved previously.

These skills will be linked and embedded to work within the make up units to create evidence and images. The units are; face painting, body painting and basic and photographic make up application.

Health and safety and client care will be embedded in all of the above units.

Entry Requirements

GCSE English, Art and one other subject grade C or above. If art has not been taken as a GCSE another subject will be accepted as long as artistic ability can be proven.

Applicant with prior industry experience will be considered.
