### Introduction

This course is provided in partnership with the University of Warwick. You will study for two years at the College, then two years at the University of Warwick, with the option to choose a social studies or health and social policy pathway.

### Study Outline

Politics, Researching Culture and Society, Sociology and Health and Social Policy. Sessions of study skills are provided during the first year and you will have unlimited access to the study support workshops throughout both years. In your first year the course will provide a broad introduction to the subjects, while Year 2 provides a deeper focus on specific topics.

### Entry Requirements

This programme is intended to provide entry to degree level studies for people who, for one reason or another, lack the usual qualifications. Recent successful study experience of some kind and a reasonable standard of written English is an advantage.
